The Blue Crane Route Municipality invites tenders for the **SOMERSET EAST MAIN SUBSTATION, FRANCISVALE RING MAIN UNIT AND WESTVIEW MINISUB UPGRADE.**

It is estimated that Tenderers should have an estimated CIDB contractor grading designation of **4EP** or higher.

Local Content requirements are applicable to all goods in Designated Sectors as determined by DTI.

Preferences will be offered to tenderers who tender in accordance with the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2011. The **90/10** Preference Point System will be applied to this tender.

Documents may be collected during working hours after **12:00pm** on **01 February 2017**. A non-refundable tender deposit of R350, *three hundred and fifty rand* payable by any means to the Blue Crane Route Municipality is required prior to the collection of the tender documents. When payment is made, please quote the following information: On cash/cheque payment.

DOCUMENTS WILL BE MADE AVAILABLE AT THE COMPULSORY SITE MEETING

A compulsory clarification meeting with representatives of the Employer and the Engineer will take place at the **Somerset East Town Hall, 67 Nojoli Street, Somerset East** on **08 February 2017** starting at **10:00** where all the contractual and tendering aspects of the document will be explained. After the clarification meeting a compulsory Site Meetings in Somerset East must also be attended by tenderers. Attendance and completion of the attendance register is compulsory for all Tenderers. Tenderers must appear on the attendance register to be considered as being present. Note that Tenderers who are more than 15 minutes late for the meeting will not be allowed to attend the meeting and will not be allowed to sign the attendance register.

Tenders must be submitted in the **TENDER BOX** situated at **Corporate Services, 88 Nojoli street, Somerset East 5850**. Tenders will be publicly opened at the address at the time indicated. A tender must remain valid for a period of **90 days** from the closing date for the submission of tenders. The lowest or any tender will not necessarily be accepted, and the Municipality reserves the right to accept a tender as a whole or in part. Telegraphic, telephonic, telex, facsimile, e-mail, posted and late tenders will not be accepted. Tenders may only be submitted on the tender documentation that is issued. More requirements for sealing, addressing, delivery, opening and assessment of tenders are stated in the Tender Data.

Only tenderers who satisfy the eligibility criteria stated in the Tender Conditions and Tender Data are eligible to submit tenders. Further, only those tender offers that achieve the minimum score for quality will be eligible for further evaluation in terms of price and preference.

The score achieved for quality (Ms) will be the sum of the scores achieved for the following criteria.

Tenderers require a minimum score of 70 in order to be further evaluated for price.

Preference Points will be offered to tenderers in accordance with the Tenderer's B-BBEE status level.
