DESCRIPTION: DRILLING OF BOREHOLES IN PEARSTON

The Blue Crane Route Municipality received a grant from Department of Water Affairs for the establishment of new boreholes in the Blue Crane Route Municipality's town of Pearston. Tenders are hereby invited for the drilling of boreholes in Pearston, of which the locations will be indicated by the Engineer and Professional Geo-Hydrologists.

The tender documents, outlining the Scope of Works and requirements will be available at the available at the offices of the Blue Crane Route Municipality, 67 Nojoli Street, Somerset East on payment of a **non-refundable document fee of R150.00** from 09h00 on Monday 07 September 2015. The Blue Crane Route Municipality offices in Somerset East are open Mondays to Fridays from 08h00 to 15h30. Cheques shall be crossed and made payable to the Blue Crane Route Municipality

A **compulsory clarification meeting** with representatives of the Employer and the Engineer will take place at the **Town Hall, Somerset East on Friday 11 September 2015 commencing at 10h00.**

The **closing date** and time for receipt of tenders is **12h00 on Monday 21 September 2015.** Where after tender will be publicly opened.

Telegraphic, telephonic, telex, facsimile, email and late tenders will not be accepted.

Tenders may only be submitted on the tender documentation that is issued.

Tenders must be placed in a sealed envelope and clearly marked **"DRILLING OF BOREHOLES IN PEARSTON (Contract 08/2015)"** and are to be placed in the **Blue Crane Route Municipal Tender Box, Corporate Services Building (opposite ABSA), 88 Nojoli Street, Somerset East.**

Tenderers must take particular note of the following:

- Only tenders complying with the requirements as specified in the Tender Data will be considered.
- Functionality criteria as indicated in the Tender Data will apply. In the event that the specified score for Functionality is not achieved (minimum 70%), the tender will be deemed non responsive. The points for Functionality of responsive tenders will not be carried forward to the Tender Evaluation.
- The tender will be evaluated according to the Supply Chain Management Policy of the Blue Crane Route Municipality. (August 2012).
- The 80/20 preference points system will be applicable, with 80 points for Price and 20 points for BBBEE Status Level Contribution.
- Tenderers must attach a valid letter of good-standing from Compensation Commissioner (FEM).

- Tenderers are required to be registered for VAT and must submit an original valid SARS Tax Clearance Certificate with the tender in order to be considered. This condition applies to all Joint Venture partners.
- Tenderers are required to submit a preliminary project specific Occupational Health and Safety Plan with the tender in order to be considered.
- Tenderers should provide proof of registration with the Borehole Association.
- Failure to supply all supplementary/clarification information in terms of the Supply Chain Management Policy may result in the tender being deemed an incomplete tender and shall not be considered for award.
- Penalties will be applied as defined in Clause 5.13 of the General Conditions of Contract (GCC 2010).

All tenders shall remain valid for a period of 90 days after the tender closing days. The only, lowest or any tender will not necessarily be accepted. BCRM reserves the right to accept part of or the full bid.
