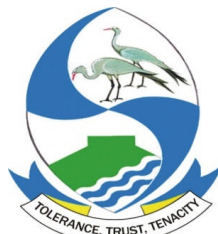

BID NOTICE

PROJECT NAME: UPGRADING OF THE WASTE WATER TREATMENT WORKS, SOMERSET EAST Contract No. T 14/2013

The Blue Crane Route Local Municipality invites tenders for UPGRADING OF THE WASTE WATER TREATMENT WORKS, SOMERSET EAST.

The contract comprises the following:

- a) Refurbishment of existing structures
- b) Completion of conversion of existing oxidation pond to biological reactor
- c) Construction of two new clarifiers
- d) Construction of new sludge recycle pump station and waste sludge pump station
- e) Conversion of an existing pond to a sludge lagoon
- f) Interconnecting pipework and minor structures
- g) Roads, stormwater and other general civil & building works

Tenderers must be registered with the CIDB in a CE Class of construction works and have a grading **Grade 7 CE** as the minimum requirement.

Only tenderers who satisfy the eligibility criteria stated in the Tender Data are eligible to submit tenders and to whom preferences will be offered.

Tender documents will be available at the Blue Crane Route Local Municipality's offices at 67 Nojoli Street, Somerset East, 5850 from **11:00 on Thursday 12 September 2013**. A non-refundable tender deposit of **R 500-00**, payable in cash or by bank guaranteed cheque made out in favour of the Blue crane Route Municipality is required on collection of the tender documents.

A **compulsory** clarification meeting & site inspection will be conducted by the Engineer commencing at the Somerset East Town Hall on **Thursday 19 September 2013** starting at **11:00**. Aspirant Tenderers must have perused and have their Tender Document comprising Volume 1 (3 Books) and 2 (1 Book) available at the meeting & inspection.

Completed Bid documents are to be placed in sealed envelopes endorsed "**BID NO: T 14/ 2013 PROJECT NAME: UPGRADING OF SOMERSET EAST WASTE WATER TRETMENT WORKS**" must be placed in the tender box at the BLUE CRANE ROUTE MUNICIPALITY offices, 88 NOJOLI STREET, SOMERSET EAST not later than 18 OCTOBER 2013, 12h00 when tenders will be opened in public.

Telegraphic, telephonic, telex, facsimile, e-mail and late tenders will not be accepted.

Tenders may only be submitted on the tender document that is issued.

Requirements for sealing, addressing, delivery, opening and assessment of tenders are stated in the Tender Data.

The tender will be evaluated on functionality first and tenderers must score a minimum of 70% to proceed to the preference points system which will be:

- 90 points for price
- 10 points for B-BBEE
