#### UPGRADING OF THE WASTE WATER TREATMENT WORKS IN SOMERSET EAST – PHASE 2: SLUDGE DRYING BEDS

The Blue Crane Route Local Municipality invites tenders for the **UPGRADING OF THE SOMERSET EAST WASTE WATER TREATMENT WORKS – PHASE 2: SLUDGE DRYING BEDS.**

Tenderers must be registered with CIDB, and have a CIDB contractor grading. It is estimated that Tenderers should have a CIDB contractor grading designation of 6CE, or higher. Tenderers must appoint a Local Emerging Enterprise, who should have a CIDB contractor grading designation of 2CE, where 10% value of the construction works shall be subcontracted. This tender will be evaluated according to points awarded for price and B-BBEE Status Level of Contribution. The **90/10** Preference Point System will be applied to this tender.

Documents may be collected during working hours after 09:00 on **Monday 23 May 2016**. A non-refundable tender deposit of **R500,00 [Five hundred rand]** is required and payable in cash or bank guaranteed cheque made out in favour of the Blue Crane Route Local Municipality prior to collection of the tender documents.
