#### TENDER NOTICE AND INVITATION TO TENDER

The Blue Crane Route Municipality invites tenders for installation of a new 300kl pressed steel water reservoir and installation of zone water meters in Pearston as well as installation of level control equipment at Hill Reservoir in Somerset East.

The estimated duration of the contract will be for **3 months**.

Tenderers must take particular note of the following:

- Only Tenderers complying with the requirements as specified in the Tender Data will be considered.
- Tenderers must be registered with the CIDB and have a valid CIDB contractor grading designation of **Grade 3 CE (R650 000 to R2 mil)** or higher.
- Joint ventures are eligible to submit tenders provided that:
  - 1) every member of the joint venture is registered with the CIDB, and;
  - 2) the lead partner has a contractor grading designation in the **Grade 3 CE (R650 000 to R2 mil) (CE Civil Engineering works)** or higher, or
  - 3) the combined contractor grading designation calculated in accordance with the Construction Industry Development Board Regulations is equal to or higher than a contractor grading designation **Grade 3 CE (R650 000 to R2 mil)**, class of construction work. This may be achieved by the following criteria:
    - Three contractors registered in contractor grading designation **2 CE**

Tender documents, outlining the Scope of Work and requirements will be available at the offices of the Blue Crane Route Municipality, 67 Nojoli Street, Somerset East on payment of a non-refundable document fee of **R 300.00** (Three Hundred Rands) from **09h00 on Thursday 12 September 2013**. The Blue Crane Route Municipality offices in Somerset East are open Mondays to Fridays from 08h00 to 16h30.

A compulsory clarification meeting with representatives of the Employer and the Engineer will take place at the **Municipal offices, Njoli Street, Somerset East** on **Thursday 19 September 2013** commencing at **09:00**. Any prospective tenderers that arrive later than 09h10 will NOT be allowed to participate in the meeting.

The closing time for receipt of tenders is **12h00** on **Friday 4 October 2013**.

Telegraphic, telephonic, telex, facsimile, e-mail and late tenders will not be accepted.

Tenders may only be submitted on the tender documentation that is issued.

Tenders documents must be placed in a sealed envelope and clearly marked “**UPGRADING OF WATER INFRASTRUCTURE IN PEARSTON & SOMERSET EAST (CONTRACT NO. T15/2013)**” and are to be placed in the Blue Crane Route municipal tender box, Corporate Services Building (opposite ABSA), 88 Nojoli Street, Somerset East.

The 90/10 preference point system will be applicable,

- 90 points for Price
- The remaining 10 points apply to B-BBEE Status Level of the Contributor.

**Tender offers will only be acceptable if:**

- the tenderer submits with his tender an original Tax Clearance Certificate issued by the South African Revenue Services (All parties to submit this information in the case of a Joint Venture).
- the tenderer must be registered with the Construction Industry Development Board in an appropriate contractor grading designation (All parties to submit this information in the case of a Joint Venture);
- the tenderer or any of its directors is not listed in the Register of Tender Defaulters ([www.treasury.gov.za](http://www.treasury.gov.za)) in terms of the Prevention and Combating of Corrupt Activities Act of 2004 as a person prohibited from doing business with the public sector; and
- the tenderer has not abused the Employer’s Supply Chain Management System.
- the tenderer has not failed to perform on any previous contract with the Employer.
- the tenderer has completed and signed Form B (Certificate of Authority for Signatory)
- the Form of Offer and Acceptance is duly completed and signed
- a preliminary project specific Occupational Health & Safety Plan is submitted with the tender
- the tenderer has completed and signed the Compulsory Enterprise Questionnaire (Form 1E) (for each of the participating firms in the case of a joint venture)
- a valid letter of good-standing from the Compensation Commissioner or FEM is attached.
- all relevant certified information is submitted with the Tender
- all other Tender Conditions are complied with.

Failure to supply all supplementary/clarification information in terms of the PPPFA may result in the tender being deemed an incomplete tender and shall not be considered for award.

Penalties will be applied as defined in Clause 5.13 of the Conditions of Contract (GCC 2010).

All tenders shall remain valid for a period of 12 weeks after the tender closing date. The lowest, or any tender will not necessarily be accepted.
